I moved to Oklahoma in 2012 and started back in Residential Real Estate, June 2013. By end of 2016, I was selling over \$10M a year. In 2017, we started our Brokerage, Castles & Homes. I am the Managing Broker with 14 other agents, yet still active as a REALTOR® as well. Over the past few years, I have helped several colleagues who reached out to start their own brokerages. I am so happy to see them succeed!

I have been a foster parent since 2004, Event chair for 7-8 events per year to fundraise \$5M+ for 4KIDS of SFL 2004-2011, public speaker on radio and large events to raise awareness for Foster Children, a CASA in OK since 2012, and am actively involved in fostering dogs, supporting rescues, and helping adopt out pets to others.
